
Re: Report of Recoupment Collected – 2010

Section 1063.14 of the California Insurance Code requires each member company to recoup policy surcharges and remit to the Association any excess recoupment of premiums paid. To enable your company to comply with the statute please complete the enclosed Report of Recoupment Collected – 2010.

Member insurers who collect surcharges in excess of premiums paid shall remit the excess to the association as an additional premium. The Association will determine the amount of your company's excess recoupment and invoice you at a later date. The excess shall be applied to reduce future premium charges in the appropriate category.

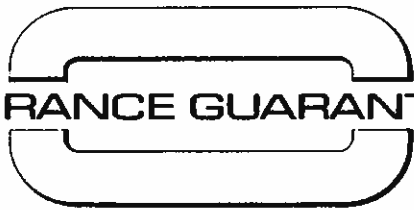
